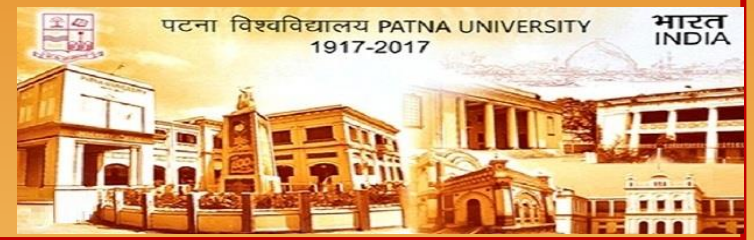

Patna University staff on mass CL, students clean Ganga ghats

PATNA: Even as the working of the Patna University (PU) office and all its allied units remained paralysed on Friday following to the commencement of the two days' mass casual leave by the non-teaching employees in support of their demands, the students and teachers of PU Hindi department utilized the opportunity in cleaning the Ganga ghats at Darbhanga House. As their classes could not be held due to the employees' strike, the students decided to resort to community cleaning of the various ghats,



including the Kali Ghat, with a view to compensating their academic loss. Accompanied by their department head Tarun Kumar and other faculty members, they cleaned the ghats and their surroundings. The sweepers of the postgraduate departments located at Darbhanga House also cooperated in the community cleaning. Senior faculty members Dilip Ram, Sitare Hind, Jainendra Kumar and Sudhanshu lauded the voluntary service rendered by students and appealed to them to keep up this spirit in future.

Meanwhile, Patna University Employees' Association general secretary Subodh Kumar claimed that the agitation launched by the employees is a total success as none has reported to his duties.

He said if their demands were not conceded after these two days' mass casual leave, all the non-teaching staff would stage a protest march to the Raj Bhavan on November 14 to press their pending demands. Demands of the agitating employees include provision of all facilities to the university staff on par with the Secretariat staff in the light of the Supreme Court judgment, restoration of old pension scheme, abolition of the pay revision cell, restoration of the Christmas holidays in universities and enhancement of the age of employees' superannuation to 65 years.

पटना विश्वविद्यालय में सेल्फ फाइनेंस में एमसीए और बीसीए कार्यक्रमों को मंजूरी

पटना. पटना विव में स्व वित्त पोषित कार्यक्रम के रूप में बैचलर ऑफ कम्प्यूटर (बीसीए) और मास्टर ऑफ कम्प्यूटर (एमसीए) को चलाने की अनुमति मिल गयी है. राजभवन ने इस संदर्भ में रेगूलेशन को मंजूरी दी है. यह कार्यक्रम च्याइस बेस्ड क्रेडिट सिस्टम (सीबीसीएस) के तहत संचालित किया जायेगा. जारी रेगूलेशन के मुताबिक इस कोर्स के लिए पटना साइंस कॉलेज

और पटना कॉलेज में 30-30 और बीएन कॉलेज और मगध महिला कॉलेज में 60-60 सीट निर्धारित की गयी हैं. इसके अलावा पांच सीट एनआरआइ के लिए निर्धारित की गयी हैं. बीसीए के लिए कुल 13600 रुपये फीस तय की गयी है. बीसीए की पढ़ाई का माध्यम अंग्रेजी रहेगा. यह डिग्री छह सेमेस्टर की है. इसमें प्रवेश कॉमन एडमिशन इंट्रेंस टेस्ट से होगा.
