Proposed Amended Ordinance for Admission of Students to Post Graduate Degree Course in Biochemistry (Semester System).

- Admission to M.Sc. Biochemistry course (Semester System) is open to candidates who have passed B.Sc. (Hons.) or M.B.B.S. examination or equivalent conducted by a University established or incorporated by law and are eligible to apply for admission.
- Admission to the Post Graduate Course in Biochemistry shall be made on the basis of the marks obtained at the Aptitude/Entrance Test conducted by the Department.
- Number of seats of the course shall be 32.
- The reservation of seats for the course shall be as per rules of the Patna University.
- The fee structure of the course per semester applicable from session 2012 will be as follows:



PROPOSED AMENDMENT IN REGULATIONS FOR M.Sc. BIOCHEMISTRY COURSE

Amendment No. 1:-

The entire existing provision in clause 1 be replaced by the following:-

Every student shall undergo a certified study extending to two years comprising 4 semesters, each semester of 6 months duration. Every year the academic session of semester I &III will run from July to December whereas of semester II & IV will run from January to June.

Amendment No. 2:-

The existing provision in clause 5 be replaced as follow:

The M.Sc. Examination in Biochemistry(semester system) shall be conducted as per regulations approved by the Chancellor of Universities of Bihar and communicated by the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar vide letter No. P.U.-12/2012-1417/GS (1) dated 05.10.2012 on the subject" Regarding approval of the proposed ordinances and regulation of M.A., M.Sc., M.Com and M.Ed courses (semester system)" together with amendments issued vide letter No P.U. (Regulations)-12/2012-1434/GS(1) dated 17.07.2013 on the subject "Regarding approval of the proposed amendments in existing regulation of M.A., M.Sc. and M.Com Courses of Patna University, Patna under semester system."

Amendment No. 3:-

The existing provision in clause 6 be replaced as follows:

a) In Biochemistry subject there shall be four semesters. The course of study in Biochemistry shall be as follows:

b) Each paper shall carry 100 marks. The examination of theoretical core papers shall be of three hours duration and the practical paper of six hours duration. The paper on dissertation/Mini Project shall also carry 100 marks (based on evaluation of the project report and viva-voce)

Amendment No. 4:- Insertion of a new clause No. 9:-

- A) Notwithstanding with the academic activities of the department and in order to provide a professional experience to students of this department, a diagnostic laboratory be established in the department equipped with sophisticated equipments meant for all latest types of Biochemical, Microbiological and Pathological tests for the diagnosis and evaluation of diseases of the samples received from patients of the University /Different Hospitals/Nursing Homes and Private Clinics on the terms and conditions mentioned below:-
 - a) Approved charges will be collected in the department for the tests from the patients.
 - Approved subsidized charges will be applicable for P.U. personnel and their dependents.
 - c) Test Report will be given under the name" P.U. Diagnostics" located in the Department of Biochemistry, Patna University, Biology Block 2,Patna Science College Campus, Patna -800005.
 - d) Tests will be carried out by the Research students of this department under the supervision of duly approved Registered Specialists.
 - e) 40% amount received from the patients will be distributed among the Registered Specialist, Medical Laboratory Technicians and Research Scholars in the following manner- Registered Specialist – 10%, Medical Laboratory Technicians – 10% and Research student performing the test – 20%.
 - f) 20% amount received from the patients will be the share of the University.
 - g) 40% amount received from the patients will be kept in the department towards the cost of the chemicals, glassware's and maintenance of the equipments.
 - h) All the rules framed by the Govt. towards providing privileges to poor sections of the Society will be applicable.
- B) The staff meant for performing Biochemical, Haematological and Microbiological tests in the Central Dispensary, Patna University should be transferred / deputed in the Department of Biochemistry for performing the same work.
