A. Description of the Analysis:

The Department received 126 (numbers) of filled-in feedback forms from the Students. The responses were analysed, and the analysis is described below:

All the students of the Department gave positive feedback of Teachers of the Department helps them to maximise their potential at different stages of learning of subjects and also raise their awareness of strengths and highlighting the areas for the scope of improvement, and identify action to be taken to improve performance by organising Seminars, Debates, Group Discussion, Class Room Presentation, Personal Counselling, Engaging and Creating awareness among students for services towards society, community and the respective neighbourhood. Students also feel that teachers of the Department give emphasis on values in education which is important for the real-life growth.

B. Description of the Shortcomings:

On the basis of the analysis of the feedback, it appears that the following are the areas in which improvement is required:

- Teamwork, empathy and support between students and teachers needs to be developed more to create the most effective teaching environment.
- Teachers of the Department working on too many roles needs to be curved so that the Pure Concentration of Teachers of the Department is improved.
- Teachers of the Department need more time to plan for creative teaching followed by timely execution.

C. Recommendations:

The Department recommends the following on the basis of the above-mentioned analysis of the feedback:

- A dynamic environment which shall bring together all students from different background with different abilities should be developed by the Department.
- In addition to classroom teaching of course materials teachers also need to prepare teaching strategies to meet students' individual needs.

A. Description of the Analysis:

The Department received 06 (numbers) of filled-in feedback forms from the Teachers. The responses were analysed, and the analysis is described below:

Total 06 (six) teachers of the Department submitted their filled-in Feedback Form which contained section 'A' for the curriculum/syllabus and section 'B' for the Teaching, Learning and Evaluation.

Almost all teachers of the Department agreed with the syllabus and its suitability for the course and the target group, i.e., students of the Department, course contents, etc. regarding the prescribed books and their availability in the Seminar Library of the Department. All teachers unanimously agreed that sufficient books and reference texts are available in the Library and students take full advantage of it. Teachers felt that there is a positive balance between the theoretical and practical part of course curriculum which helps students to complete in the globally competitive Job market.

Regarding section 'B' i.e., the teaching learning and evaluation teachers of the Department were of opinions that although infrastructural facilities are there in the Department, however, it needs a Midas Change especially from the spectrum of Wi-Fi Classroom, Common Room both boys and girls, Canteen, Sports fields, provision of lifts and sufficient lighting, and in other factors such as tests and examinations, adoption of new techniques of teaching such as PPT Presentation.

Group Discussion, Learner's Participation and other modes of experimental teaching, teaching and research and the administration, etc teachers shown their positivity.

B. Description of the Shortcomings:

On the basis of the analysis of the feedback, it appears that the following are the areas in which improvement is required:

Almost all teachers felt that the modernisation of infrastructure of the Department in view of the growth and development of PG Students of MBA Programme of the Department is necessarily required. Further, vacancies of teachers in the Department should be filled-up immediately. Recruitment modality of teachers of the University's system also needs a change especially in the field of Management teachers are required to be clinically experts too.

C. Recommendations:

The Department recommends the following on the basis of the above-mentioned analysis of the feedback:

- University authorities needs to be apprised of about all the shortcomings of the Department on priority.
- The Department should go for collaboration with Industries and corporate world for a required positive and dynamic change in the Department in relation to infrastructure, teaching, research and an increase in Placement facilities.
- D. Action Taken/Action to be Taken (if any):

Currently many positive steps have been taken-up by the University and the Raj Bhawan, Patna and its academia. Even, Government of Bihar, Peoples' representative and the University Grants Commission (UGC) as a whole have shown its serious concern relating to the upliftment and unique growth of the University.
