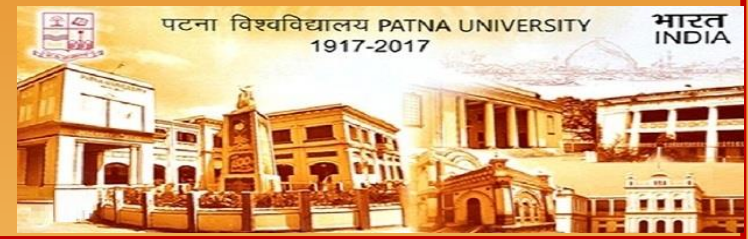

619 nomination papers sold in three days for Patna University Students' Union polls



PATNA: If the sale of nomination forms is any indication, the craze for contesting Patna University Students' Union (PUSU) polls being held on November 19 after a gap of three years has increased considerably. As many as 619 nomination papers were sold during the last three days. There will be direct elections for all the five key offices, including president, vice-president, secretary, joint secretary and treasurer. Election of class representatives (councillors) would be held constituency wide. There is one councillor for every 1,000 students. The unit wise number of councillors are Patna Women's College (five), Magadh Mahila College (three), B N College (two), Patna College (two), Patna Science College (two), Vanijya Mahavidyalaya (one), Patna Law College (one), Women's Training College (one), Patna Training College (one), College of Arts and Crafts (one), faculty of social science (two), faculty of humanities (one), faculty of science (one), and faculties of commerce, law and education (one).

The sale of nomination papers had started at the PU sales counter at 10am on Thursday and ended at 3pm on Saturday. Now students can file their nomination papers between 10am and 3pm on November 7, 9 and 10 at Wheeler Senate House. Scrutiny of nomination papers would be held on November 11 and the list of valid nominations would be published the same day. The grievance redressal committee would meet at 3.30pm on November 12 and convey its decision on candidates' grievances to the VC at 5pm. Students would appeal before the VC at 6pm the same day.

Withdrawal of nomination papers would be held till 3.30pm on November 14 and the final list of candidates would be published at between 6-7pm the same day. Polling would take place from 8am to 2pm on November 19 and the counting of votes would be held 4pm onward the same day, said PU students' welfare dean Anil Kumar. PUSU elections chief returning officer Khagendra Kumar said a 15-member committee comprising senior teachers and staff has been constituted to ensure smooth conduct of elections. He added all contesting candidates would have to observe the code of conduct prescribed in the statutes based on the Lyngdoh Committee report. "They would not indulge in wall writing, nor will they use printed materials in campaigning. They would not organize any feast or party on the campus in the course of elections. Any student found violating the code of conduct would be debarred from contesting the elections. Besides, students who have been charge-sheeted or convicted in any criminal case would also not be eligible to contest the elections," he said.

All the contesting candidates will have to obtain a certificate of 'no academic year' from the office of the examination controller between 10am and 3pm till November 9 before filing their nomination papers. The Lyngdoh Committee clearly states that only regular students without any break in career can contest the union elections.
