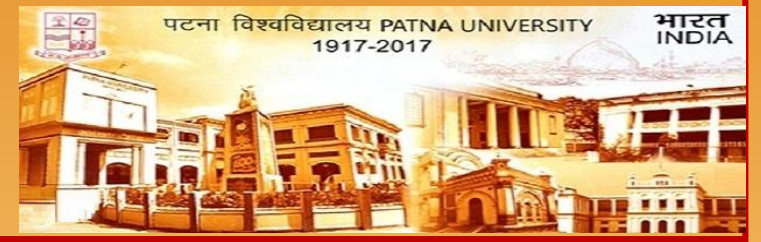

पावर प्वाइंट प्रेजेंटेशन से समझाया एनएसएस का कर्तव्य

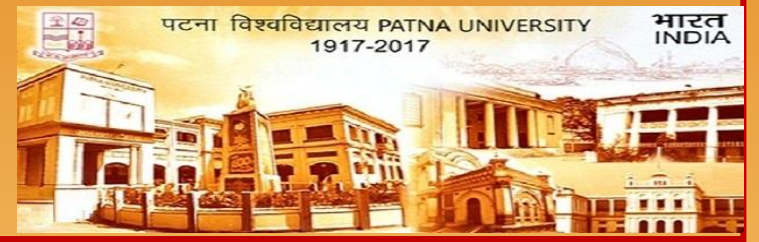

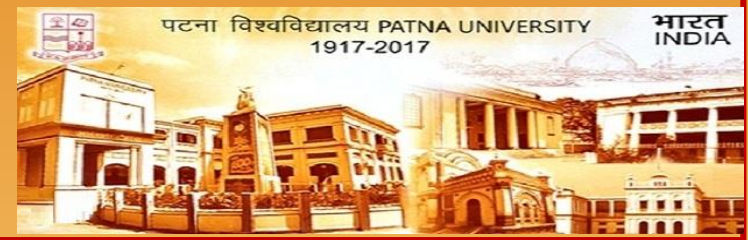

Patna's Vanijya Mahavidyalaya: A pioneer college in commerce

Patna: Vanijya Mahavidyalaya (VM), a constituent unit of Patna University (PU), is an institution meant exclusively for commerce students. It is just like Delhi's Sri Ram College of Commerce for many bright boys and girls interested in pursuing a course in commerce in Bihar.

It imparts undergraduate and post-graduate courses to prepare competent executives for business concerns, industries and the public and private sector undertakings. The institution also runs bachelor course in business administration (BBA) on self-financing basis.

The history of growth and development of this institution is quite interesting. After Bhim Rao Ambedkar Bihar University separated from PU in December 1953, PU's applied economics and commerce department was left only for the postgraduate teaching. Hence, BCom classes were started, but due to lack of space and separate building, it was started in Patna Law College, and its principal was made the professor in-charge of the new institution. In 1956, a post of independent professor in-charge was created and, in March 1957, it was transferred to Patna College campus from where the work of its development and expansion started.

Keeping in view the increasing de-

mand for commerce education, pre-commerce classes and B Com Part-I classes were introduced, which were later converted into ICom and BCom classes.

In 1961-62, honours classes were introduced at the undergraduate level. Later, in July 1966, it was transferred to the newly-constructed arts and commerce building on Patna College campus and the principal of Patna College looked after it as its principal.

Ultimately, in December 1974, BCom classes of Patna College got the new nomenclature as 'Vanijya Mahavidyalaya' (a name coined by the then PU vice-chancellor Acharya Devendra Nath Sharma). The administrative and academic responsibilities of the institution were

handed over to the seniormost commerce teacher, Padmadeo Narayan Sharma, who took great pains for the desired growth of this institution.

This co-educational college has produced a large number of chartered accountants who have made their mark in the country and abroad. With a view to ensuring all-round development of students' personality, the college lays special emphasis on sports, games and social activities. Its students have always excelled in inter-university sports tournaments and cultural festivals organized at the state and national levels.

College principal Nagendra Kumar Jha said that the institution has signed an MoU with the TCS under which month-long training camps are organized to ensure placement of students in different organizations. A number of college students have got lucrative job offers after attending a recent training camp, he said.

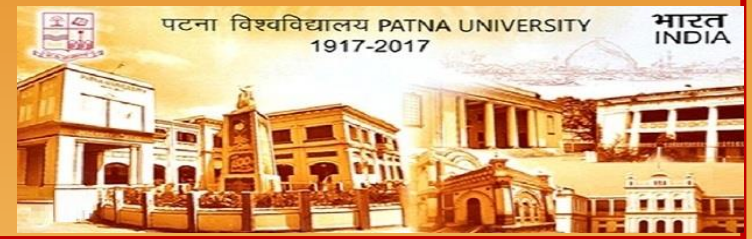
The principal further said that the college is contemplating to start a six-month job-oriented certificate course in enterprise resource planning (ERP) with GST from the next session. A detailed proposal in this respect has been submitted to the university.

Jha, however, regretted that in spite of being one of the best institutions for commerce education in the state, it does not have its own campus till date.

PWC holds workshop on career in psychology

Patna: The psychology department of Patna Women's College organised a workshop on "Career options in psychology with special reference to clinical psychology" here in which a large number of students participated.

Addressing the students at the workshop on Saturday, key resource person Pranay Kumar Gupta of the psychology department at the College of Commerce, Arts and Science under Patliputra University spoke at length about the subject and its various branches and the career options available in all these branches.

He enumerated various career options of teaching, undertaking research and counselling in different branches of psychology, including

child psychology, neuropsychology, organisational psychology, and sports psychology.

He further pointed out that clinical psychologists must possess

knowledge of psychological theory and practice and have an interest in how humans think and interact with one another. They must have strong research and team working skills but

they must also be able to work on their own. Students who pursue clinical psychology should have strong critical-thinking skills and have the ability to quickly identify the effectiveness of a treatment plan and then make adjustments to better benefit their clients.

He said there are a variety of career opportunities for clinical psychologists. These include substance (drug) abuse counsellors, human resource positions, family or marriage counsellors, forensic psychologists, child psychologists and learning disabilities specialists.

At the outset, psychology department head Nupur Sinha welcomed the guests. Students from both undergraduate and postgraduate departments as well as their teachers attended the workshop.
