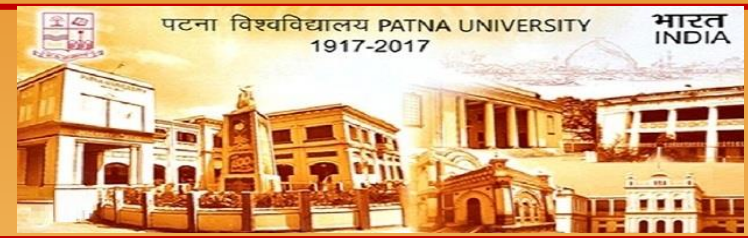

## Cabinet approval for varsity teachers' promotion statute

PATNA: In a relief to the college and university teachers in Bihar, the state will move ahead with the promotion of hundreds of teachers under the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) 2018 pending since 2021 after the Bihar cabinet cleared it last week, officials said.

Additional chief secretary Dipak Kumar Singh said that a fresh notification would be issued in a few days by the Raj Bhawan. "The Raj Bhawan already suspended the previous order. Now with cabinet clearance, it will issue the fresh notification," he added.

**TEACHERS' PROMOTIONS REMAINED WITHHELD DUE TO AN ORDER BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN JULY 2021, WHICH WAS LATER SUSPENDED**

Teachers' promotions remained withheld in the colleges and universities due to an executive order by the department of education in July 2021, which was later suspended. However, despite the suspension of the order, promotions

remained stuck. There has been growing resentment among teachers over the issue. The then advocate general Lalit Kishore as well as the state higher education council expressed dissatisfaction over the delay in promotion by the state officials and called it 'unjustified'.

Though some universities granted promotions in the rank of associate professors and professors during 2018-21 based on CAS, the government order stopped further promotions and created a tough situation for the teachers as well as the universities. The uncertainty led to more pendency of promotions despite the March 2020 Patna high court order stating that "universities cannot keep cases of promotions

pending for more than six months." The University Grants Commission (UGC) too in the past issued guidelines for the early resolution of promotion cases and the filling up of large-scale vacancies.

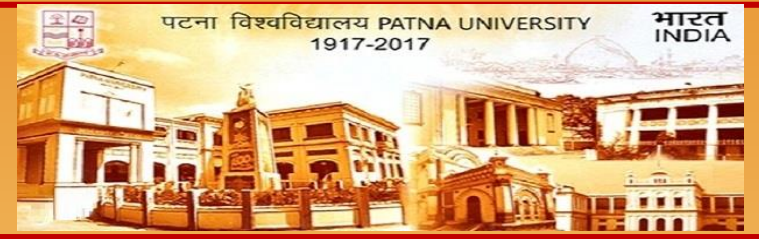
Since July 2021, all due promotions to hundreds of university teachers were stopped and later Raj Bhawan set up a three-member committee comprising vice-chancellors to resolve the problem. On the recommendation of the committee, the promotion statute got the chancellor's consent a year later in July 2022 and after that, the government decided to take the matter to the cabinet.

It took another six months to get cabinet assent.

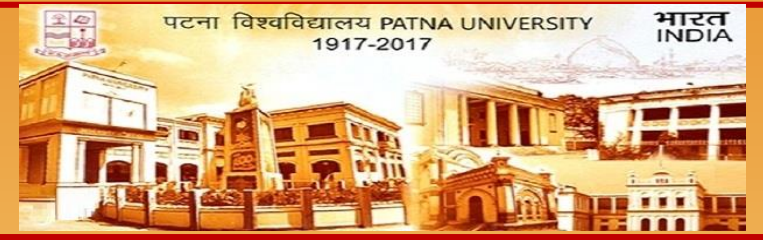
## पटना विश्वविद्यालय के विकास में पूर्ववर्ती छात्र सहयोग करेंगे

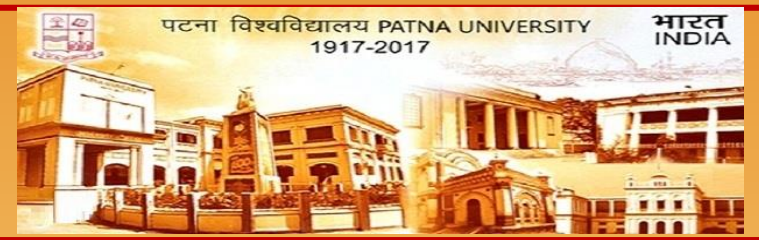
## पीयू में रिफ्रेशर कोर्स का होगा आयोजन

### Prized Collections Of Manuscripts At PU

The manuscripts section of 123-year-old Patna University library continues to attract a larger number of scholars from within and outside the state because of its prized collections. This section contains altogether 5,763 old and rare manuscripts of national and international importance, some of which are written on leather, 'Bhojpatra', palm leaves, Nepali paper, animal skin, woods and on paper with gold and silver linings. These valuable manuscripts written in Maithili, Bengali, Tibetan, Awadhi, Tamil, Sanskrit, Chinese, Oriya, Devnagri, Nepali, Arabic, Persian and Urdu languages belong to the 13th century and later periods. Some of the notable manuscripts are Saroj Kalika and Malti Madhvan of 14th Century AD, Tolinama, Risala Sifat Jaruriya of 15th Century AD, Jahangirnama, Brihad Jatak, Khatmaye Ferhanshe of 16th Century and Mashnavi Seen Khushro and Laila Majnu of 17th Century AD. These manuscripts were collected by Vishnu Lal Shastri, Jagannath Mishra, Maulana A Balkhi, K A Imam and others. Besides, there are a number of silver coins belonging to the 13th and 14th Century AD. The manuscripts are well preserved and are always the main attractions for the visitors of Patna University library. PU authorities have, of late, initiated steps for the digitization of these manuscripts with the help of National Manuscripts Mission.
