Amendment Notification

The following amendments have been made in the existing Statute for Students Union, 2018 in the Universities of Bihar promulgated vide this Secretary's letter No.BSU-42/2017-87 /GS(I), dated 12-01-2018:-

1. 9(ii) "Five members of the Central Council elected by its members in accordance with the system of proportionate representations by means of single transferable vote from among themselves provided that not less than two out of 5 members will be girls" may be read as follows:-

"9(ii) Six members of the Central Council elected by its members in accordance with the system of proportionate representations by means of single transferable vote from among themselves provided that not less than two out of 6 members will be girls"

2. 14(ii)(d) "For LLM students 27 years" may be read as follows:-

"For LLM and M.Ed. students 27 years"

3. "Clause 26(i) He has exceeded age mentioned in the Lyngdoh Committee recommendation as approved by Supreme Court of India.

26 (ii) He has completed 7 years from 1st July of the Calendar year of passing -2 examination taken together the examinations in one or more than one Universities.

26(iii) He has been convicted of a criminal offence including moral turpitude or he has been punished by the University/College for an act which is coercive in nature and constitutes a threat of life and property or

26(iv) He has been found guilty of and punished for the use of unfair means in any examination of a University or Board or any Govt. Organization." may be read as follows:-

"Clause 26(i) He/ She has exceeded age mentioned in the Lyngdoh Committee recommendation as approved by Supreme Court of India.

26 (ii) He/ She has completed 7 years from 1st July of the Calendar year of passing +2 examination in one or more than one Universities.

26(iii) He/ She has been convicted of a criminal offence including moral turpitude or he/she has been punished by the University/College for an act which is coercive in nature and constitutes a threat of life and property or

26(iv) He/she has been found guilty of and punished for the use of unfair means in any examination of a University or Board or any Govt. Organization.”

4. “13(c) To be added in the Statutes as” may be read as follows:-

“13(c) In case of tie between two candidates for any post at the time of declaration of results the Chief Election Officer shall conduct the toss with the help of the coin to decide the result of the election.”

The existing Statute may be deemed amended to the above extent.
