About the Patna University (PU)

Patna University, which has entered 108 years of existence, is the 7th oldest university in the Indian subcontinent. The history of Patna University parallels to the educational, cultural, political and economic growth of modern Bihar. Currently, all faculty members of the department are actively involved in various research areas, such as aquatic toxicology, fish biology, toxico-genetics, ecophysiology, limnology, river ecology, biodiversity conservation, stress biology, entomology, genomics, transcriptomics and proteomics. The department also has some foreign collaboration. Presently, the department is offering CBCS-based four semester M.Sc. program in Zoology and Environmental Science and Management (self-financing) and a PhD programme in Zoology. This department entered the 75th year of its inception, and this conference is one of the events planned to mark the platinum jubilee year of the department.

It integrates various disciplines, including biophysics, biotechnology, bioinformatics, and synthetic biology, to address key challenges in healthcare, environmental sustainability, and industry.
